We're delighted to be working with your child this year. Our offer is designed to re-engage learners, rebuild confidence, and secure strong next steps into college, training or employment. Below is everything you need in one place.

## **Key Information at a Glance**

### **Cohorts & Times**

**Morning Cohort:** 9:00am–12:15pm

**Afternoon Cohort:** 12:45pm–3:30pm

Both cohorts follow the same curriculum to ensure parity and consistency.

### **Curriculum**

**English & Mathematics first** (applied, real-life contexts in a supportive, relational environment).

**Wider learning:** Business & Enterprise, Immersive Learning & Digital Media (with VR), Creative Arts, PSHE (VR-supported), Personal & Social Development, Work Experience & Life Skills.

**Platforms:** Century Tech (our primary adaptive platform) + Microsoft Teams (Microsoft Classrooms) for live lessons, resources and feedback (used on-site and for remote learning).

### **Student Rewards Programme (from Sept 2025)**

Weekly recognition (certificates), **individual and cohort leaderboards**, and **termly rewards**.

**Individual points:** min 0 · typical 5–15 · max ~25–30.

**Cohort points:** min 0 · typical 15–25 · max 29.

Any RedEverywhere staff member can nominate a student for positive achievements.

### **Exams (with EHCP support where applicable)**

If your child is preparing for GCSEs, we can arrange for them to sit exams at our Hubs in partnership with their host school.

If your child has an EHCP, the host school will provide the agreed additional support; a RedEverywhere staff member will be on-site to offer further support in line with the EHCP.

### **Dress Code**

Wear comfortable, appropriate clothing for learning.

If returning to mainstream school in the afternoon, arrive to us in your school uniform in the morning.

We discuss personal presentation as part of preparation for college and work.

## **Catering & Refreshments**

If your child receives Free School Meals at their mainstream school, lunch will be provided at RedEverywhere.

Please share dietary requirements and food likes/dislikes.

Water and flavoured water are available during the day.

## **Remote Learning (when needed)**

Your child can access learning through Century Tech and Microsoft Teams if they cannot attend in person.

We follow normal safeguarding procedures; attendance and wellbeing are monitored.
